Señorio de Sarria Rosado, 2014 Spain 13.5% 4.50/18.00

Classic Navarra rosé; fresh elegant and zesty.

Château L'Ermitage 'Tradition' Rosé, 4.90/19.60

Costières de Nîmes, 2014 France 13%

Very clean, ripe and appealing - bigger, rounder and more modern than Provence rosé

Champagne & Sparking Wine

Dolce Colline Prosecco Brut, Italy NV 13.5% 19.75

Fresh and gently fruity fizz from northeast Italy (Veneto) with citrus and green apple aromas. Delicate and lively on the palate with ripe, lightly grapey fruit, zesty acidity and a clean, refreshing finish.

Lunetta Prosecco Spumante, Italy NV 11% 22.00

A deliciously light and fruity Prosecco with hints of apple and peach on the nose and a fresh, softly sparkling palate with characters of soft ripe stone fruits.

La Vida al Camp Cava Rosé Reserva, Spain NV 11.5% 26.50

Delicate red fruit aromas lead on to a palate of citrus and white flower characters, with a touch of cassis. The fizz is fresh and persistent.

A stunning, award winning Champagne that delivers on all fronts!

Dessert Wine & Port

Domaine de Grange Neuve Monbazillac (50cl), 2009 France 13% 15.00

A fabulous dessert wine, sweet and luscious with a great backbone of fine acidity for a clean finish.

Krohn Ambassador Ruby, NV Portugal 19% 2.80 50ml

Rich and full Ruby Port, with smooth, soft finish. *Half bottle* **12.50 37.5cl**

Krohn LBV, 2009 Portugal 20% 3.20 50ml

LBV Port with bags of flavour and length on the finish - from an eminently reliable Port house.

Krohn Colheita 1982, Portugal 21% 5.00 50ml

A stunning richly flavoured Colheita, drinking perfectly after 15 years in barrel!

Krohn Colheita 1976, Portugal 20% 10.00 50ml

Remarkably elegant Vintage Port with hints of orange and delicate acidity.

Krohn Vintage 1965, Portugal 20% 135.00 70cl

A beautifully mature vintage Port from 1965 - complex and seductive

White Wine

Cuvée Jean-Paul Gascogne Sec, 2014 France 11.5% 3.90/15.60

A deliciously aromatic, bright and zingy dry white!

Les Volets Chardonnay, 2013 France 12.5% 4.50/18.00

Fresh, flavoursome southern French Chardonnay in a Burgundian style.

Domaine du Pré Baron, Touraine Sauvignon Blanc, 2014 France 13% 4.75/19.00

Has a beautiful perfume; think gooseberries steeped in elderflower cordial.

Supperier Grüner Veltliner Federspiel, 2013 Austria 12% 22.00

A fresh and fruity, yet crisp, organic white from Austria's signature grape variety.

Duc de Mornay, Picpoul de Pinet, 2014 France 13% 18.00

Slowly becoming France's worst kept secret Picpoul is the seafood wine of choice amongst canoeists.

Turkenheim Reserve Pinot Blanc, 2013 France 12.5% 18.00

Alsatian wine at its very best, full of fruit yet still off dry, mussels were made for Pinot Blanc.

Domaine de la Motte Chablis, 2012 France 12.5% 26.00

A classic Chablis from vines grown on the famous Kimmeridgian clay with nervy, mineral fruit but added depth from a small addition of some oak-aged wine into the blend.

Domaine de Maltaverne Pouilly Fume Premier Millesime 2014 France 12.5% 29.00

The top blend of Sauvignon grapes from two small terroirs in the Loire Valley, it really doesn't get much better than this.

Sancere Silex 2014 France 13.5% 28.00

Terroir plays an essential part in this wine. Only sauvignon grapes grown on one selected vineyard with silex (flinty) soil structure give the wine a rich mineral quality.

Clos Bagatelle Aux Quatre Vents Blanc, Pays de l'Hérault, 2014 France 13.5% 20.00

Clean and well balanced, this is best enjoyed whilst it's still young and fresh.

L'Olibet 'Les Cabrides' Viognier, 2014 France 14% 19.00

Refreshingly lean, counterpoised by the near-tropical lilt of floral scents

Red Wine

Borsao Garnacha, 2014 Spain 13.5% 3.90/15.60

Medium bodied red with red berry & warm, spicy flavours. Ideal with meat, pasta dishes and cheese.

Les Cepages Oublies, 2013 France 13% 4.50/18.00

The Cinsault & Greache Noir varieties produce a wine with a fresh fruity palate and velvety smoothness interwoven with untamed flavours.

Guelbenzu 'Azul' Tempranilo Cabernet Merlot, 2012 Spain 14.5% 4.90/19.60

Rich and full of flavour with ripe blackberry and plum notes, toasty oak and a touch of pepper and spice.

Les Pivoines Beaujolais Villages, 2013 France 12% 19.50

Unpretentious simple enjoyment whilst offering character and class.

Boutinot la cote sauvage Côtes du Rhône Village, 2011 France 14% (Magnum 1500ml) 55.00

A big bottle of wine with bags of taste, morello cherries, liquorice & cinnamon to name but a few.

Valenciso Reserva, 2008 Spain 14% 35.00

Valencisco only make one wine a year, this one, and if they don't think its good enough to carry their name they sell it to someone else.

Barolo bussia dardi le rose, 2010 Italy 14.5% 59.00

I've tasted a few Barolos and believe me this is a prince among them. Meaty yet floral ,fruity and tannic. Roast beef and Yorkshire puddings with lashings of good gravy eaten in a rose garden.

Manon Tempranillo, 2013 Spain 13.5% 24.00

Black cherry and lightly herbal aromas. Pure black fruit on the palate with savoury notes and ripe tannins.

Le Fou Pinot Noir, Pays d'Oc, 2014 France 12.5% 18.00

Layers of really lovely fruit, it's very drinkable and perfect if you prefer a riper, fruitier style of Pinot.

Les Volets Malbec, Pays de l'Haute Vallée de l'Aude, 2014 France 13% 18.50

Youthful and yummy, a true French classic.

Feria et Fêtes Grenache Noir, Pays des Côtes Catalanes, 2012 France 12% 22.00

A lovely, warm, brambly and dense Grenache Noir from the deep south of France.
