## *White Wine*



**Plazzo del Mare, Sicily, 2016 12%** 4.15/16.50

The Catarratto grape from Sicily, you've never heard of it, neither had I. Its great drink it before it becomes the next pinot grigio

**Forge Mill Chenin Blanc, NV, South Africa 13%** 4.25/17.00

From the Riebeek Valley, plenty of citrusy zing. Great with seafood or on its own.

**The Capeman, Sauvignon Blanc, NV, South Africa 12.5%** 4.75/19.00

It's Sauvignon Blanc, it's cold, it's wet—you'll love it.

**Campo Flores Organic Verdejo Sauvignon Blanc, 2016, Spain 12%** 20.00

Vibrant, fresh & organically grown. Grapes grown on old bush vines just as they have been for centuries.

**Land of Plenty Sauvignon Blanc, 2017, New Zeland, 12.5%** 22.00

Familiar Marlborough zest with exciting tropical fruit, mandarin & grapefruit overtones.

**Famille Morin, Picpoul de Pinet, 2016, France 12.5%** 24.00

Only ever grows around lake Pinet in the south of France. Perfect with mussels, oysters and langoustines

**Sunburnt in Central Victoria Chardonnay, 2015, Australia, 13%** 26.00

Blisteringly good buttery Chardonnay. Nice orange label.

**Charles & Charles Single Vineyard Riesling, 2016, USA, 12%** 30.00

Outstanding Riesling from the Art den Hoed vineyard in the Yakima Valley. An unusual balance of exotic fruit, richness and acidity.

**Tenuta Olim Bauda Gavi, 2016, Italy, 12.5%** 30.00

Northern Italy's favourite white grape, (Cortese) taken to its peak.

**Domaine Grossot Chablis, 2015, France. 12.5%** 36.00

Top quality Chablis, charming rural scene on the bottle, unlikely the peasants depicted could afford it.

**Silga Rueda Verdejo, 2016, Spain 12.5%** 18.50

Zesty, zingy aromatic wine from high altitude vineyards in central Spain. Great with just about anything. Pinot Grigio for grown-ups.

**Domaine Fichet, Mâcon-Villages, 2015, France 12.5%** 27.00

Creamy and buttery Chardonnay from southern Burgundy. Ace with fish and chips

**Domaine de Grange Neuve, Monbazillac, 2011, France, 13.5% (50cl)** 22.00

A classic desert wine from the Perigord. Ideal as an aperitive, with blue cheese or afters.

## *Rose Wine*

**Bella Modella La Farfalla, Pinot Grigio Rose, NV, Italy. 12%** 4.75/19.00

Its dry, pink and pinot grigio I would drink it if you paid me but you will Perfect for sunny days in the beer garden.

**Felicette Rose, 2017, France 13%** 20.00

Dedicated to Felicette, the first cat in space. Also amongst the first cats to enjoy wine.

## *Champagne & Sparking Wine*

**Terre di Giulio Prosecco, NV, Italy 11.5%** 4.85/22.00

Exceptional sparkling wine with consistent national and international and global acclaim.

**Biscardo Millesimato Vintage Prosecco, 2016, Italy 11.5%** 25.00

A real smooth operator and a real find for us. A second bottle is probably inevitable.

**Champagne Pierre Mignon Premier Cru Grande Reserve Brut, NV, France 12%** 31.00

Tiny producer making wonderful hand crafted Champagne. Will make any occasion special.

Stunning wine from a small producer, soft and generous, packed with fruit.	
<b>Ai Galera, "Poetico", 2016, Portugal 13%</b>	<b>17.00</b>
