*Red wines are made from red (black?) grapes and their colour derives from the skins and the depth of that colour from just how long the juice sits with the skins in contact.*

*But here's the rub; as well as colour, the skins bring tannins and texture. Mouthfeel. The longer you leave them macerating, the more you get. Which of course in the case of white (green?) grapes means no redness at all. Just texture. And a certain orangeness*
